

Criminal and Law Enforcement Injuries Compensation Scheme Payment Schedule
(For incidents occurring on or after 1.4.2009)

<i>Type of payment grant in respect of death or personal injury</i>	<i>Level of grant</i>	<i>Condition of grant</i>
1. Burial grant	\$11,140 per person.	If the burial expenses were paid whether in full or in part by Government (such as under the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance Scheme) or by one of the charitable funds, the amount of grant shall be reduced by the amount of such payment.
2. Death grant (a) Loss of sole wage earner where there are dependants (b) Loss of a wage earner where there are dependants and another wage earner(s) remaining in the family (c) Loss of a parent who was not a wage earner where there are children under 15 years of age	\$106,800 for one surviving dependent family member plus \$8,900 for each additional surviving dependent family member, up to a maximum of \$151,300 . \$53,400 for one surviving dependent family member plus \$8,900 for each additional surviving dependent family member, up to a maximum of \$97,900 . \$53,400 for one surviving child under 15 plus \$8,900 for each additional surviving child under 15, up to a maximum of \$97,900 .	If the beneficiary is an adult who is mentally unsound or found unconscious or is a minor without surviving parent/ legal guardian, payments will be made on the advice of the Social Welfare Department.
3. Disability grant	From \$128 up to a maximum of \$128,160 based on the First Schedule or Section 9(1)(b) of Employees' Compensation Ordinance, Cap. 282 of the Laws of Hong Kong; abated to 2/3 for persons aged 60 and over.	
4. Injury grant	From \$533 up to a maximum of \$44,360 depending on gravity of injury.	The amount is assessed according to the number of days of sick leave/hospitalization. The maximum is 180 days. Injury grant is payable where the injury period is 7 days or more before death. Injury grant should cease from the date on which the victim becomes eligible for the disability grant, or upon the death of the victim.
5. Interim maintenance grant	From \$297 up to a maximum of \$53,400 .	The amount is assessed according to the number of days of sick leave/hospitalization. The maximum is 180 days. Interim maintenance grant is payable to a wage earner suffering loss of earnings as a result of incapacity to work, or to a non-wage-earning parent with a child under 15 years of age. Payment of interim maintenance grant should cease upon the death of the victim.
