

**Special Child Care Centre cum Early Education & Training Centre at
1/F Community Ambulatory Care Centre of Tang Shiu Kin Hospital, Wan Chai**

The Department is ready to support the following minor alteration works.

1. To convert the existing Male Changing Room and Female Changing Room into 2 Children Toilets (3 nos. of WCs for each toilet). The following provision may be included in each of the Children Toilet unless otherwise stated :
 - A. Sanitary Fitments
 - 3 nos. WCs with low level cistern, top of WC seat around 300mm from floor level
 - 3 nos. hand wash basins sized around 470mm x 310mm with cold water tap, top of the basins to be fixed around 510mm.
 - 1 no. telephone type shower mixer head with hot and cold water supply in one of the Children Toilets only
 - B. Compartment
 - Wall partition for WC to be proprietary solid core phenolic resin faced and sealed with indication bolt for each cubicle
 - C. Toilet Accessory
 - 3 nos. toilet paper roll holders
 - 3 nos. coat hooks
 - 3 nos. liquid soap dispensers
 - 3 nos. mirrors
 - 1 no. of towel rail in one of the Children Toilets only
 - D. E & M Provision
 - One number of water heater for shower in one of the Children Toilets
 - Fan heater or radiator for space heating in the Children Toilet with shower facilities
 - Emergency call bell system
 - E. The existing fittings & fixtures inside the Rooms not suitable for the required toilet facilities/relevant statutory standards will have to be demolished/altered & necessary touching up works to suit shall be allowed.
2. The centre shall comply with all relevant Statutes and Code of Practice including but not limited to the Buildings Ordinance and the Child Care Services Ordinance and Regulations. The existing fittings & fixtures inside the centre not suitable for the relevant statutory standards and the required toilet facilities, subject to the agreement and conditions of Landlord, will have to be demolished/altered & necessary touching up works to suit shall be allowed

Remarks: The total cost of conversion works must be kept **below \$400,000.**
