販運人口屬嚴重罪行

- 販運人口是指以暴力、欺詐或脅迫等手段以求剝削他人的行為，包括性剝削或強迫勞役。
- 販運人口在香港屬嚴重罪行。任何人把另一人帶入或帶出香港進行賣淫活動，不論是否得到該人同意，都屬違法，一經定罪，最高刑罰為監禁 10 年。

保持警覺

- 為了保護自己，如你計劃到香港工作，應該：
 - 知道未來僱主的姓名、地址和電話號碼。可以的話，在啟程前與未來僱主聯絡，以核實確已受聘，並查詢工作性質、薪酬和居住條件等資料。
 - 確保已獲香港入境事務處發出你必需的工作簽證。訪港旅客不得在香港工作。
 - 簽署僱傭合約前，細閱合約內容。
 - 保存所簽署合約的副本。
 - 把啟程時間、在港住址和電話號碼告訴親友。
 - 如在香港有朋友，也把朋友的聯絡地址和電話號碼告訴親友。

- 抵達香港後：

- 應把護照和護照副本分開存放在安全的地方，不要把護照交給任何人代管。
- 聯絡親友，並保持聯繫。
- 保持警覺，以免被隔離，以致無法與家人、朋友、社交圈子或相關團體接觸。

- 如懷疑自己會成為或已經成為販運人口集團的受害人，請致電 (852) 2860 8366 與香港警務處 (有組織罪案及三合會調查科) 聯絡。
- 緊急情況下，請撥 999 尋求警方即時協助。

Human trafficking is a serious crime

- Human trafficking is an act which involves the use of force, fraud or coercion on a person for the purpose of exploitation that includes sexual exploitation or forced labour.
- Human trafficking is a serious crime in Hong Kong. Bringing a person into or taking a person out of Hong Kong for the purpose of prostitution, with or without that person's consent, is subject to a maximum penalty for imprisonment of 10 years.

Staying Alert

- To protect yourself, when you are making plans to work in Hong Kong, you should:
 - Learn the name, address and telephone number of your future employer. If possible, contact your future employer before leaving for Hong Kong to verify your offer and ask about your work, pay and living conditions.
 - Ensure you have obtained the necessary employment visa from the Hong Kong Immigration Department. Visitors are not allowed to work in Hong Kong.
 - Read the employment contract carefully before signing.
 - Keep a copy of the signed contract.
 - Tell your family and friends of your itinerary and give them the address and telephone number in Hong Kong.
 - Leave your family and friends with the address and telephone number of your friends in Hong Kong, if any.

- When arriving in Hong Kong, you should:
 - Keep your passport and a copy of your passport separately in safe places. Don't give anyone your passport to look after.
 - Contact your family or friends and keep in touch with them.
 - Stay alert to avoid being kept in isolation or barred from contacting your family, friends, social circle or relevant groups.

Seeking assistance

- If you suspect you will or have become a victim of human trafficking, call the Hong Kong Police Force at (852) 2860 8366 (Organised Crime and Triad Bureau) for assistance.
- In an emergency, call 999 for immediate help from Police.
