

Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) vs. Common Application







ERP Applications vs. Common Applications Compared

ERP

- High initial development and implementation costs
- High system maintenance and upgrading costs
- High staff training costs and steep learning curve

- Has the vision and strategy for tech system needed
- Expertise of IT team to choose the right vendor
- Good knowledge of technology stacks and industry standards
- Perform detailed business and problem analysis
- Expertise in BPR and best practices within the sector
- Provide precise system requirements and specifications

- Clear communication on the digital transformation objective from the NGO management
- Readiness of each relevant department or team
- Resource management during the transition phase

Budget

- Low initial development and implementation costs. No overrun of your budget
- Subscription costs instead of high maintenance costs
- Moderate staff training costs

Internal IT Team

- Expertise to choose the right technology approach
- Ops team to choose the solution (Ops vs. IT driven)
- Knowledge of current tech stack and industry standards is less critical

Business Analysis & Project Management

- Perform application research rather than detailed business analysis
- Common applications are built with best practice
- Provide output objectives

Organisation transformation readiness & change management

- Clear communication on the digital transformation objective from the NGO management
- Each department has higher flexibility on when to be ready
- Less change management issues
