The new District Elderly Community Centres (DECCs) have been implemented since 2001/02 to provide elderly persons with a comprehensive package of support services. From 1 April 2003, the Social Welfare Department has also upgraded all multi-service centres for the elderly to DECCs to provide expanded functions and appropriate services for elderly persons and their carers, so as to enable elderly persons to continue living in the community.
