社會福利署(社署)自2002-03年度開始，推出新的長者鄰舍中心(鄰舍中心)，為長者提供更全面的支援服務。此外，由2003年4月1日起，社署已將大部份的長者活動中心(活動中心)提升為鄰舍中心，以擴展其功能及為長者和護老者提供適切的服務，以協助長者在社區安享晚年。在2014-15年度，社署已增撥經常撥款予所有活動中心，以提升其服務至鄰舍中心水平。

The new Neighbourhood Elderly Centres (NECs) have been implemented since 2002/03 to provide elderly persons with a more comprehensive range of support services. From 1 April 2003, the Social Welfare Department (SWD) has also upgraded most of the social centres for the elderly (SEs) to NECs to provide expanded functions and appropriate services for elderly persons and their carers, so as to enable the former to continue living in the community. For 2014-15, SWD has further allocated an additional recurrent funding for all SEs to raise their standard of services to that of NECs.
