

Partnership Fund for the Disadvantaged (Tenth Round Dedicated Portion Application)

Partnership Fund for the Disadvantaged (PFD)'s Dedicated Portion aims at promoting "Government-Welfare Sector-Business-School" collaboration to implement more after-school learning and support programmes for primary and secondary students from grassroots families to facilitate their whole-person development. The PFD will provide dollar-to-dollar matching grants to donations made by business corporations to support welfare non-governmental organisations (welfare NGOs)/schools implementing social welfare projects. The maximum grant for each project approved is HK\$4.5 million.

APPLICATION CRITERIA :

- Charitable welfare NGOs having tax exemption status under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap. 112); or
- Public sector primary and secondary schools including government schools, aided schools and caput schools, and schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme; and
- Obtain donations from business corporations registered and operating their business in HK or from charitable trusts/foundations established and managed by these business corporations.

APPLICATION METHODS :

- Download the application form from the website of Social Welfare Department and forward the completed application form with supporting documents to the Secretariat; or
- Submit online application in the GovHK (www.gov.hk/en/residents/) or via the "E-Forms" in the SWD's website (www.swd.gov.hk/en/eservice/eform/index.html). After submitting the online application, applicants are required to submit supporting documents to the Secretariat within two weeks.

APPLICATION PERIODS* :

Period 1 – 20 December 2023 to 30 April 2024

Period 2 – 20 December 2023 to 31 October 2024



* Welfare NGOs/Schools can submit proposals at any time from 20 December 2023 to 31 October 2024. The PFD Secretariat will process and grant approval to the applications in accordance with the chronological order that the applications are received.
