Community Care Service Items

Centre-based Services
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Full-time day care service (12 sessions per week, each session not less than 4 hours)● Day care session (4 hours)● Day care service outside normal operating hours● Transportation service (vehicle to/from centre)● Escort for day care service (home to/from vehicle)
Home-based Services
<p><u>Home Care Services</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Rehabilitation exercise<ul style="list-style-type: none">- delivered by physiotherapist / occupational therapist- delivered by supporting staff¹● Nursing care<ul style="list-style-type: none">- delivered by enrolled / registered nurse- delivered by supporting staff¹● Personal care delivered by supporting staff² <p><u>Home Support Services</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Home making● Escort● Meals delivery● Elder sitting<ul style="list-style-type: none">- delivered by professional staff²- delivered by supporting staff¹ (includes home respite service provided by personal care worker)● On-site carer training<ul style="list-style-type: none">- delivered by professional staff²- delivered by supporting staff¹● Environmental risk assessment/home modification recommendation delivered by physiotherapist / occupational therapist
Others
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Residential respite service● Speech therapy service● Soft meals (additional item for day care service / meals delivery)● Rental Service of Assistive Technology products● Home-based services (except meals delivery and soft meals) / speech therapy service delivered outside pledged service hours³

¹ Supporting staff means trained physiotherapy artisan, occupational therapy assistant, health worker, personal care worker, home-helper, etc.

² Professional staff means enrolled/registered nurse, physiotherapist, occupational therapist or registered social worker.
