LONG-TERM SUPPLEMENT

An annual long-term supplement is payable to families involving any member who is old, disabled or medically certified to be in ill-health for the replacement of household and durable goods if they have received assistance continuously for 12 months or more. The amount payable depends on the number of such eligible members in the family. Able-bodied adults/children are not entitled to long-term supplement.

SINGLE PARENT SUPPLEMENT

A monthly supplement is payable to single parent families to recognize the special difficulties which single parents face in bringing up a family.

COMMUNITY LIVING SUPPLEMENT

A monthly supplement is payable to persons who are old, disabled or medically certified to be in ill-health and who are not living in institutions to better support their stay in the community.

TRANSPORT SUPPLEMENT

A monthly supplement is payable to severely disabled persons who are medically certified to be 100% disabled or requiring constant attendance and in the age group of 12 to 64 to encourage them to participate more in activities away from home, thereby enhancing their integration into society.

RESIDENTIAL CARE SUPPLEMENT

A monthly supplement is payable to persons who are old, disabled or medically certified to be in ill-health and who are living in non-subsidised residential care places to ease their financial burden.

SPECIAL GRANTS

In addition to standard rates and supplements, special grants are payable to meet other special needs. (The eligibility criteria and levels of payment of the various types of special grants can be found in 'A Guide to Comprehensive Social Security Assistance'.)

Able-bodied adults/children are only entitled to rent allowance, water charge allowance, grants to cover schooling expenses for children (including grants to cover school fees, etc.), grants to cover child-care centre fees and burial expenses.
