Pusat Lansia Wilayah Setempat (NECs) baru telah diberlangsungkan sejak 2002/03 untuk menyediakan serangkaian layanan bantuan komprehensif bagi lansia. Sejak 1 April 2003, Departemen Kesejahteraan Sosial (SWD) juga telah meningkatkan sebagian besar pusat sosial bagi lansia (SEs) menjadi NECs untuk menyediakan fungsi yang diperluas dan layanan yang tepat bagi lansia dan perawatnya, agar lansia dapat terus tinggal di komunitasnya. Untuk tahun 2014-15, SWD selanjutnya mengalokasikan dana tambahan bagi semua SEs untuk meningkatkan standar layanan hingga setara dengan NECs.

The new Neighbourhood Elderly Centres (NECs) have been implemented since 2002/03 to provide elderly persons with a more comprehensive range of support services. From 1 April 2003, the Social Welfare Department (SWD) has also upgraded most of the social centres for the elderly (SEs) to NECs to provide expanded functions and appropriate services for elderly persons and their carers, so as to enable the former to continue living in the community. For 2014-15, SWD has further allocated an additional recurrent funding for all SEs to raise their standard of services to that of NECs.
